

# Lebanon Ride Sharing initiative

A common service that continues operating during the emergency response



To reduce operational costs, optimise security tracking, and improve fleet efficiency, humanitarian organisations in Lebanon have joined forces to share passenger transport capacity.

The Lebanon Ride Sharing Initiative brings together 8 humanitarian organisations, building on four years of successful collaboration to provide safe, reliable, and cost-effective passenger mobility across key operational routes.



## PASSENGER FLEET SHARING

Focus on maximizing existing resources to ensure safe and cost-effective mobility.



## SHUTTLE SERVICE

Dedicated passenger van services operating on the most demanded operational routes.



## ONLINE RESOURCE

Real-time coordination via an online shared movement plan to spot and create opportunities.
